

Nursery production


- 104 nurseries

Change of nursery sales % (compare to year 2006)




Labour costs %


(compare to year 2006)



Share of sales of nurseries (%)




Plants in retail sales, value

Nursery Growing in Finland --- Future...

- Number of nurseries will decrease
- Average size of nurseries will increase
- Issue of propagation forces industry to update production lines
- Production will be focused on special domestic varieties and clones

Propagation

- Lack of specialized young plant producers
- Number of produced seedlings and barerooted plants is decreasing in Europe
- A need for new culture of producing and shareing material between growers
